Welcome to your dedicated Travel Plan Pack. Here you will find information on how to take up more sustainable travel opportunities in Woolston. As part of the Centenary Quay development, a Travel Plan has been produced, which sets out strategies to increase the level of sustainable travel and minimise the impact of traffic associated with the Centenary Quay development on local roads and the environment. By promoting sustainable travel and monitoring the travel choices taken by residents, the Travel Plan aims to:

- Support a range of sustainable transport alternatives to provide the residents with options for sustainable travel to and from the site.
- Develop an awareness of the options for sustainable travel to and from the site and local area amongst residents.
- Promote car sharing, walking, cycling and public transport as safe, efficient, affordable alternatives to private cars and highlight the health and environmental benefits of using sustainable travel modes.
- Minimise the impact of car-based travel to Centenary Quay on the local and strategic highway network and environment.

Here you will find a range of up-to-date information on walking and cycling routes, public transport, and other local opportunities in and around Woolston.

CENTENARY QUAY

Centenary Quay is located in Woolston in the east of Southampton, with the River Itchen to the west. With local facilities available in Woolston, and Southampton city centre, there are many different options to explore.



YOUR LOCAL AREA

Centenary Quay is situated in Woolston, to the west of Victoria Road. Woolston has a range of retail, leisure, education and employment opportunities which are easily accessible for you as a resident.

WALKING AND CYCLING

Centenary Quay is surrounded by a number of walking and cycling routes providing access to destinations both nearby and across Hampshire.


Woolston High Street is situated on Victoria Road and provides a number of shops including Superdrug, and Woolston Post Office. In addition, there are a variety of cafes and other services on offer including Boots Pharmacy, Piggy's Café, Greggs and Hairdressers Hair salon. There is also a Lidl nearby.

To the southeast of the site is Weston Shore Promenade, which is ideal for taking leisurely walks along Southampton Water.

Route 2 of the National Cycle Network runs directly through Woolston providing a cycling connection into Southampton City Centre via the Itchen Bridge in the west and both Netley and Hamble in the east. This route forms part of a 361-mile long distance route between Dover in Kent and St. Austell in Cornwall.

The Woolston Travel Hub located within the Colonnade Car Park is an Enterprise Car Club serving Woolston, situated adjacent to Woolston Bridge Link Road with two spaces available. Enterprise offers three different memberships for individuals who wish to use the service on a basic, annual or standard monthly basis.

MICRO-MOBILITY

VOI operate within the city of Southampton to provide approximately 1,400 electric-powered scooters across 200 docks on a rental basis to the public. Currently there is a rental dock adjacent to Harbour House. With 96 VOI bicycle bays located throughout the city centre, offering access to 175 regular pedal bikes and 195 e-bikes.

ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING



- With the sale of new petrol and diesel cars to be banned from 2035 electric cars will become the forefront of car travel.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

BUS TRAVEL

The nearest bus stops to the site are located on Vosper Road approximately 250m away from the site. The bus stop provides a shelter, seating and is featured with a flagpole and timetabled information.

This stop is served by the following route:

- Bluestar 17 between Weston and Adnac Park

There are also additional bus stops 700m away on Portsmouth Road which both accommodate a bus shelter with seating, a flagpole and timetable information.

This stop is served by the following routes:

- Bluestar 10 between Southampton City Centre and Sholing
- Bluestar 13 between Southampton City Centre and Harefield

RAIL TRAVEL

SCHOOL TRAVEL

YMCA Woolston Nursery

YMCA Woolston Nursery is located a short walk away on Victoria Road. It can be accessed by walking along Victoria Road where there are dropped kerbs and tactile paving provided throughout the route.

Woolston Infant School

Woolston Infant School is located on Florence Road and can be accessed via foot or cycle. It can be accessed via Victoria Road, Obelisk Road and West Road. There are three zebra crossings provided on Obelisk Road, with one directly adjacent to West Road, providing safe access to the school for pedestrians.

Ludlow Infant School and Junior School

Ludlow Infant and Junior School are situated on the same site on Ludlow Road, to the northeast. Both schools can be accessed via foot or cycle

along Victoria Road, a pedestrian signalised crossing is provided at the Portsmouth Road Bridge Road junction. From there, a footpath is located opposite Manor Road South which continues in a north east direction ending on the corner of Poole Road and Ludlow Road.

Oasis Academy Sholing

Oasis Academy is situated in Sholing and is the nearest secondary school from Centenary Quay. The school can be accessed via cycle or foot along Victoria Road, Radstock Road, Bishops Road and then, Sholing Road. There are footways along the whole route.


WHAT'S NEXT?

MONITORING REPORTS & SURVEY

As part of the Travel Plan, Centenary Quay required to monitor the uptake of sustainable travel over a 5-year period. This monitoring will inform the success against the targets which are to be agreed with Hampshire County Council.

Monitoring will be in the form of questionnaire surveys throughout the monitoring period. These surveys will determine the level of different forms of travel undertaken by residents and will help understand any barriers to particular types of travel. The results from these monitoring surveys will be reviewed and monitoring reports will be produced to understand the effectiveness of the Travel Plan which allow for any changes to be made.

The results of the surveys and the monitoring reports will be uploaded to the Travel Plan website.
